<p>This involves giving children opportunities to speak and listen in a range of situations and to develop their confidence and skills in expressing themselves.</p> <p>Including;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Speaking</li> </ol>	<p>This involves providing opportunities for children to be active and interactive, and to develop their co-ordination, control, and movement. Children must also be helped to understand the importance of physical activity, and to make healthy choices in relation to food.</p> <p>Including</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Moving and Handling</li> <li>2. Health and self care</li> </ol>	<p>This involves helping children to develop a positive sense of themselves and others, form positive relationships and develop respect for others, develop social skills and learn how to manage their feelings, understand appropriate behaviour in groups, have confidence in their own abilities</p> <p>Including</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Self confidence and self awareness</li> <li>2. Managing feelings and behaviour</li> <li>3. Making relationships</li> </ol>

<p>This involves encouraging children to read and write, both through listening to others reading, and being encouraged to begin to read and write themselves. Writing</li> </ol>	<p>This involves providing children with opportunities to; practise and improve their skills in counting numbers, calculating simple addition and subtraction problems. Describe shapes, spaces, and measures.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Numbers</li> <li>2. Shape, space and measure</li> </ol>	<p>This involves guiding children to make sense of their physical world and their community through opportunities to explore, observe and find out about people, places, technology and the environment.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. People and communities</li> <li>2. World</li> <li>3. Technology</li> </ol>	<p>This involves supporting children to explore and play with a wide range of media and materials. It involves providing children with opportunities and encouragement for sharing their thoughts, ideas and feelings through a variety of activities in art, music, movement, dance, role play, and design and technology.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.
