**Cupernham Infant School Sports Day**

We are looking forward to another exciting Sports day this year and very much hope that you will be able to join us.

To ensure a swift start and an organised, fun and safe day:

- Children will need to come to school already dressed in their PE kit, including, where possible, a t-shirt in their house colour (you will be notified of your children's colour team shortly - they may differ from last year however siblings will be in the same team colour).
- Please ensure that your child has a water bottle, sun cap, sweatshirt or other appropriate clothing depending upon the weather.
- You are invited to stay to have a picnic with your child after the races. If you would like us to supply a packed lunch for your child on Sports Day please fill in the attached sheet and return it to your class teacher or the office by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May. (The school packed lunches usually consist of a savoury filled bread roll, fruit snack and a pudding). Please note there will be no hot meals available on this day.

**IF IT IS HEAVY RAIN OR THE GROUNDS ARE UNSAFE, UNFORTUNATELY THE DAY WILL BE CANCELLED AND WE WILL HAVE A NORMAL SCHOOL DAY - YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED VIA TEXT AND EMAIL**

- Once you have dropped your children off in class, please wait in our playground, avoiding any equipment that has been set up for the activities.
- Events will start at 9.20am and will be mainly on the junior school field.
- The morning will be divided into two parts. During the first part of the morning the children will compete in a rotation of fun races which will demonstrate a range of PE skills. The children will be in class groups and the events have to be tightly timed so please be flexible in keeping up whilst also keeping out of the flow of activities as we leap from station to station!
- We will have a break at around 11am when the children may return inside for a long drink stop and snack.
- After the break we will return to the Junior school field to take part in our running race finale. Please ensure you take a seat behind the coned area to allow the children plenty of space for running.
- We will then announce the winning teams.



- To bring our Sports Day Celebrations to a close we would like to invite you to stay for a picnic on our playground. Please bring along your picnic, picnic blanket and collect your child from the classrooms after the races, where you will be asked to sign them out.
- You are welcome to have an early finish to round off the special day, however, any children being returned to school for the remainder of the afternoon must be returned and signed back in at their class door at 1.15pm for registration.

As we are a separate school, unfortunately siblings from the Junior school cannot be taken out of school early.


