

Literacy

In Literacy we will be writing a recount of our visit from the fire brigade.

We will be writing a firework poem.

We will then be moving on to a non-fiction topic all about the Great Fire of London.

Look out for newspaper articles, fact books and historical documents!

Carry on with your weekly spellings homework's as well as practising the common exception words in the back of your spellings books. Don't forget your lovely cursive handwriting!

Numeracy

We will be beginning with a focus on money - recognising coins and notes and their worth, and making amounts in different ways. *Can you use money at home to buy things and make amounts?*

We will be learning about multiplication and division and using our skills to problem solve. *Don't forget to use your TT rockstars code to practise at home if you have it!*

We will then move onto fractions - finding halves, quarters and thirds.

We will learn about telling the time. *Can you practise telling the time at home? (o'clock, half past, quarter past / to and discuss 5 minute intervals)*

We will finish by continuing to work on our number bonds and using these to help us with our number problem solving. *Continue to practise your number bond rapid recall at home (to 10 / 20 / 100)*

History

Get ready to become experts in the events of the Great Fire of London.

We will be learning lots of facts about historical events as well as deciding how we can learn best about historical events. We will also be getting hands on with some artefacts from that time.

Could you go to the local library and find a non-fiction book about the Great Fire of London?

RE

Our RE topic is Angels and will link closely to Christmas and how this is celebrated by Christians.

PSHE

During our 'Fabulous Us' sessions we will be thinking about how to stay safe. This will include fire safety, internet safety and how to look after ourselves when we are out and about.

We will be using techniques such as 'Freeze Frame' to learn about the Great Fire of London, but our main focus this half term will be preparing for our Christmas Performance...a little closer to the time!
