#### Year R

It is lovely to see the children settled back into their learning after the Easter break – we have enjoyed sharing their adventures and discussing how many Easter eggs we all ate!


This week we have launched our 'Down on the Farm' topic and have been writing lists about animals we think we will see on the farm. We have enjoyed role playing as vets and talking about what animals need to be healthy and grow.


In maths, we have been practising our careful counting and finding ways to count larger groups of objects.

Our new sensory area outside is up and running and the children are loving this new calm space. We are super excited for our school trip on Monday.









#### KS1

#### Year 1

What a wonderful start to the summer term Year 1 have had! In English, we have read the story of 'The Storm Whale' and role-played walking along the beach in a storm. We then used this experience to write a setting description of a stormy beach. Within maths, we are developing our knowledge of one more and one less of numbers up to 50 and estimating where these would be on a blank number line. We have also learnt about belonging in Judaism. We focussed on the weekly tradition of Shabbat and explored what is inside of a synagogue.

#### Year 2

Year 2 have really enjoyed reading the first few chapters of the book 'George's Marvellous Medicine'. The first chapter about 'Grandma' really capture their imaginations and they have loved writing a character description about her. In History, the children became detectives and had to look at different artefacts to try and work out who they belonged to and what they would have been used for. They used their super inference skills and worked out that we will be learning about Florence Nightingale. In Maths, they have been learning to tell the time to the hour, half past the hour and quarter to and past the hour. What a busy week they have had!
