#### Year R


#### KS1

#### Year 1

In **Year 1** this week we have been writing about the story of The Billy Goats Gruff. We have been focusing on writing sentences using adjectives. In Maths, we have been learning to compare quantities using the language fewer, more and same. In History, we were comparing old and new toys. We discussed how some older toys are still popular now.



Over the last few weeks, Year 2 have been busy creating their own dinosaurs and creating exciting fact files outlining what they look like, what they eat and where they live. They have been using exciting adjectives to add description as well as joining ideas using conjunctions. In history, they have been using their exploratory skills to discover more about Mary Anning and have been learning about key events in her life, linking this to the concept of chronology. As artists, they have been looking at clay techniques in preparation to sculpt their own clay dinosaurs. What a super few weeks of learning they have had!







## **Hot Topic - Attendance**



Attendance will be a regular feature in our newsletters as it's important to share with you why good attendance matters. Research shows that absence from school, for whatever reason, can disadvantage a child by creating gaps in learning, which affect a child's ability to succeed.

As such, we have a dedicated team who monitor all absence thoroughly and all attendance data is shared with the Local Authority.

We will make contact with you and arrange a meeting if we have any concerns regarding your child's attendance. If your child's attendance level is falling towards 90%, then we will contact you directly to raise our concern. Please support us by giving your child the best opportunities through good attendance at school.

#### Attendance Ladder



Penalty Notices - As set down by the Department for Education, Penalty Notices can be issued for unauthorised absence. In Hampshire, Penalty Notices are issued when a pupil has had 10 or more half-day sessions (equivalent to five school days) of unauthorised absence, in the last 10 school week period.

We are committed to providing an education of the highest quality and work together to secure this for all our children. Every child has a right to access the education to which he/she is entitled. Parents and teachers share the responsibility for supporting and promoting excellent school attendance and punctuality for all.

If you are considering <u>any</u> type of absence for your child/ren from school, you must contact the school office who will be able to send you the appropriate Hampshire County Council forms. We will then be able to register your child/ren correctly.
