Year R

Continuing with 'Room on the Broom,' the children have enjoyed character hunting and sequencing the items lost on the witch's journey. The children have been very excited to create their own 'Room on the Broom' book, using CVC words and caption writing!

In Maths, we have been recognising and discussing the properties of 2D shapes in our learning environment. Throughout play, the children have been using prepositional language, when building mini dens for their 'Room on the Broom' characters. In addition, the children have really enjoyed finding and representing numbers 1-5 using lots of different resources. Well done Year R!







KS1

Year 1 have loved our new book 'Grandad's Camper' and getting to write post cards this week as if we are the main girl from the story. We have been learning to work systematically in Maths looking at our number bonds to 10 and getting outside lots with this. We have also enjoyed starting our Nativity rehearsals and our D&T work all about flags ready to create our own. Well done Year 1

Year 2 have been continuing their learning about Mary Anning and thinking carefully about how her discoveries impacted the science community. They have had great fun learning about dinosaurs and have been using the new knowledge they learnt to design their own, thinking carefully about its appearance, diet and habitat. We look forward to reading the fact pages they are going to be writing about them. In Maths they have been learning to use an empty number line to add and subtract 10s from any two digit number. Keep up the hard work Year 2.




Christmas Lunch Menu on Wednesday 13th December. There is no need to book in advance, the children will choose on the day. HC3S Special Menus will be catered for.
