YEAR 1 Summer 2

MATHS

This half term in maths, we will be learning to multiply using the correct symbol. We will be revisiting and consolidating place value of numbers to 50 and 100. We will be revisiting and securing skills in addition and subtraction. We will be using number lines, jottings and our mental maths skills. We will be learning about money, also halves, and quarters.

THE ARTS AND DT

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SCIENCE

We will be learning about different materials and their properties. We will be describing these properties and investigating which material is best for making a waterproof coat for a pirate on a ship during a storm!

We will be following our Jigsaw scheme of learning. This half term we will be learning all about 'Changing Me'. We will learn how we are all unique; know who to talk to if they are worried about change and also look forward to change.

COMPUTING

We will be learning how to create an animation. We will work in groups to plan a short sequence and then use photographs to create animation sequences.
