Literacy:

In Literacy we will be visiting the beach to help us with our writing.

We will be looking at the Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch and innovating our own lighthouse problems.

We will then be exploring other beach texts that will drive their writing and be a stimulus.

RE and PSHE: In RE we will be looking at the story of Easter. They will also be looking at belief and what that means for different people.

PE: In PE we will be doing multi skills. Our focus for this half term is sending and receiving.

Art: After our visit to the beach we will be making clay tiles to sell at our beach shop.

Numeracy:

This half term we will be looking at multiplication and division. We will be using a range of strategies to solve problems including arrays. We will be investigating the inverse relationships between these two operations.

We will be reading scales in divisions of 2,5 and 10 in practical situations and learning position and direction including half turn, quarter turn and three quarter turns.

We will be refining our mental strategies for the four operations.



Science:

In Science we will be focussing our learning on animals and humans. We will be looking at underwater creatures and how they are suited to the habitat they live in. This will also link to food chains and what different animals have to eat to survive. We will be looking at a variety of different offspring and the basic needs of animals including humans.

Geography:

In Geography we will be exploring the weather and how this impacts the beach. We will also be looking a human (manmade) and physical (natural) features of a beach. We will be developing our mapping skills using a key and making it clear to follow.
