- ❖ Your child will be making a flip book giving information about the animals that they met during Jonathon's Jungle Roadshow.
- ❖ Your child will be reading a book all about a Koala and producing some fiction writing to help the Koala solve a problem.

THE ARTS AND DT

ART: We will be looking at aboriginal art and making our own aboriginal painting.

MUSIC: We will be composing a piece of music to go with pictures from a journey through Australia.

THE QUEEN'S JUBILEE

- ❖ Your child will be learning all about the Queen and why we are celebrating her Jubilee. We will be having a Jubilee picnic on the last day of term.

MATHS

- ❖ Odd and Even - Your child will learning to recognise odd and even numbers.
- ❖ 3D shapes - Your child will be learning to recognise and name 3D shapes. They will also learn about some of the properties.
- ❖ Division - Your child will be learning to share into equal groups using part whole models and bar models.
- ❖ Number- Your child will be learning how to find the missing number in an addition and subtraction number sentence.

SCIENCE

Animals

- ❖ Your child will be recapping the different animal groups (mammal, reptile, birds etc.) and the characteristics of each of these animal groups.
- ❖ Your child will be learning that different animals have different characteristics, and how they are adapted to survive in different habitats.

- ❖ They will be taught how to make friends and be respectful to their friends.
- ❖ They will learn how to solve disputes.

- ❖ Your child will also be learning how to take a photo on a camera.

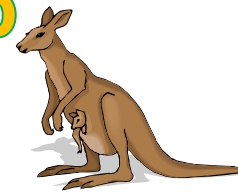
PE
