<p>Cardboard castles Use any junk or boxes you may have to make a castle. Use your toys to explore afterwards.</p>	<p>Simon says Encourage moving and following instructions, e.g. stand up and spin clockwise.</p>	<p>Paper aeroplane Create a paper aeroplane and have a competition to see which one flies the furthest.</p>

<p>Pet rocks Find a special rock if possible and keep it safe by looking after it.</p>	<p>Book marks Create a book mark by drawing your favourite characters on it and decorating it.</p>	<p>Build an obstacle course This could involve star jumps in the living room, hops along the hallway or using items such as balls and skipping ropes.</p>
<p>Hide and Seek Who can find the best place to hide?</p>	<p>Noughts and Crosses Have a competition to find the fastest way to win.</p>	<p>Read books Share your favourite books with one another. Why is it your favourite?</p>
<p>Treasure hunt Find different materials, e.g. find something which is bumpy?</p>	<p>Performance. You could perform a dance show, sing or showcase your talent.</p>	<p>Board games Work on taking turns, following instructions and careful counting.</p>
