Reading	FaceTime/Skype a family member/friend- see if they can test you on your tricky words!	Re-tell one of your favourite stories. Can you act the story out? Could you make props or puppets too?	Snuggle up and share a story with your teddies. Teach them how to use your robot arms!	Listen to a story read to you by a grown up. Talk about the characters, make predictions about what might happen next. Discuss what you thought about the story at the end.
Writing	Practice your letter formation- check they are formed correctly and the right way round.	Write as many words as you can with the digraphs 'sh' and 'ch' in.	Can you choose a tricky word and write a sentence with it in?	Look at the under the sea picture (resource on the website) Can you label it? Can you write a caption for it? Can you make up your own story around it?
Maths	A pirate ship has crashed into an island and has broken; they need you to design and build a new one. You could use lego, junk modelling etc.	Can you make some number flash cards 0-20? Can you match the correct amount of objects for each number?	Quick fire one more/one less than a given number between 1-10 or 1-20 Check you are secure with numbers to 10 before moving on to the numbers to 20.	Can you make a repeating pattern using objects from around your house? <i>E.g. fork, knife, fork, knife</i> or paint the pattern <i>e.g. red, yellow, red, yellow</i>
Topic/ Life skills	Can you sing some nursery rhymes? (Songs on BBC School Radio- Nursery Rhymes)	Can you make a junk model sea creature using recycled materials?	Can you bake a cake? Make sure you carefully weigh out the ingredients and use those muscles to mix that mixture!	Create a poster about how to wash your hands properly.
