Week 8	<p>Focus Sound: y making an /i/ sound at the end of a word.</p> <p>Focus Tricky Words: Revise all year 1 and 2 tricky words using resources on the home learning pages.</p>	<p>Spelling rule→ When there is a y at the end of a word, sometimes it makes the long ‘igh’ sound.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can you read the words written down? • Can you play the teacher game with an adult (the children know how to play this game)? • Can you find as many items around your house that have the sounds in and write them using the correct ay sound? • Can you write some of these words in sentences? • Can you find any of the words that fit this rule in a book? 	<p>Cry Fly Dry Try Reply July Fry Shy Why</p>

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<p>Week 9</p>	<p>Focus Sound: ‘al’ making the /l/ sound at the end of a word. Focus Tricky Words: Revise all year 1 and 2 tricky words using resources on the home learning pages.</p>	<p>Teach rule → If you are adding the /l/ sound to a word to change it then it is sometimes ‘al’ e.g. magic → magical, herb → herbal. ‘al’ can also be added after these letters → m, n, r, v, w. Or these digraphs → sh, ch, qu, th.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practise writing these words in a sentence. • Write the words twice on paper and play pairs with an adult or sibling. • Write the words in rainbow writing. • Can you find any of these words in books you are reading? 	<p>Magical Herbal Medical Hospital Mental Legal Total Capital Animal Oval Rival.</p>
<p>Week 10</p>	<p>Focus Sound: Words ending in il Focus Tricky Words: Revise all year 1 and 2 tricky words using resources on the home learning pages.</p>	<p>Spelling rule → Some words use ‘il’ to spell the final syllable.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write the words twice on paper and play pairs with an adult or sibling. • Write the words in rainbow writing. • Can you find any of these words in books you are reading? • Can you spell these words out of construction or art materials? 	<p>Civil Evil Devil Gerbil Lentil April Pencil Fossil Nostril Pupil Peril</p>

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<p>Week 11</p>	<p>Focus Sound: el at the end of a word. Focus Tricky Words: Revise all year 1 and 2 tricky words using resources on the home learning pages.</p>	<p>Spelling rule→ ‘el’ can be added after these letters → m, n, r, v, w. Or these diagraphs → sh, ch, qu, th There are some exceptions to this rule.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write the words twice on paper and play pairs with an adult of sibling. • Write the words in rainbow writing. • Can you find any of these words in books you are reading? • Play Kim’s game. Get a grown up to write the words down. <p>Week 12</p>	<p>Focus Sound: le at the end of a word. Focus Tricky Words: Revise all year 1 and 2 tricky words using resources on the home learning pages.</p>	<p>Spelling rule→ ‘le’ is the most common way to make the /l/ sound at the end of a word and it comes after these letters → b, c, d, f, g, k, p, st, t, z.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practise writing these words in a sentence. • Write the words twice on paper and play pairs with an adult of sibling. • Write the words in rainbow writing. • Can you find any of these words in books you are reading? 	<p>Cable Bible Hobble Wobble Circle Treacle Uncle Ankle Sprinkle Candle Bundle</p>
