- Avoids gathering outside the school as we need these paths and areas clear to help the flow of families trying to social distance.
- Maintains social distancing (over 2 meters from other families) whilst travelling to school, leaving school and on the school site.
- Ensures that if you are waiting to pick up your child, you maintain 2 meters away from other parents and carers.
- Follow our one-way system we have in place at school. The small gate backing onto the field is the
 entrance for all children, apart from Wrens class who use the main gate. All parents should then exit
 using the small gate on the infant school playground.

As an added preventative measure, we are recommending and politely requesting that parents/carers wear face coverings when on school site to drop off or collect your children and when at the school gate from Thursday 5th November. Although there is no guidance to wear masks outside at present, we would like to encourage as many of you that can to wear a mask.
