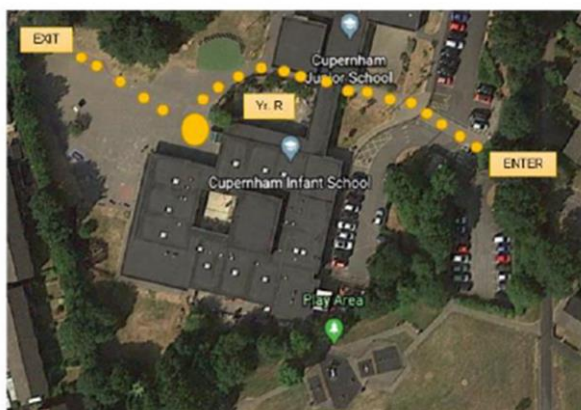
Staggered Start Times
