




What the children will learn in Year 1

- Add and subtract numbers to
- Solve addition and subtraction problems.
- Represent number bonds to 10 and 20 and related number facts.

What the children will learn in Year 2

- Add and subtract 2 digit numbers within 100 including crossing a 10.
- Recognise the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction.
- Mentally add and subtract 1 and 2 digit numbers for mental fluency.

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Some ideas to support learning at home.

Quick fire number bonds "4+??=10"

Adding up money in your money box.
You could start with adding up all the 10ps.

Lots of finger addition and subtraction within 10.

Add up your shopping as you go around the shop and calculate the change.

Weigh out ingredients for a cake and ask 'How many more grams do I need?'

Take turns writing number sentences for each other.

Hide number cards around the house. Get your child to go and find two, add them together and then take one away from the other.
