












Reading Strategies

| I use the pictures to help me. |  |
| I sound out/blend words I don't know. E.g. "C-A-R-P-E-T" "CAR - PET" "CARPET" |  |
| I can read tricky words by sight. |  |
| I read on to see if I can work out the meaning of a word I don't know. |  |
| I can break words down into syllables. E.g. "en - joy - able" "Enjoyable" |  |
| I use words I can see around me or that I have read before. I notice if a word looks like another word I already know. E.g. <i>would</i> , <i>could</i> , <i>should</i> . |  |
| I listen to what I am reading to see if it <u>makes sense</u> . |  |
| I look for smaller words inside words. |  |
| I ask questions to help me with my reading if I don't understand. |  |
| I go back and read a word or sentence again if I <u>don't understand it</u> . |  |
| I use punctuation to help me make sense of what I am reading. |  |
