

English

This half term we are going to be looking at different texts with the themes of heroes and medicine. We are going to retell the story of The Lion and the Mouse. We will also think about the work of Greta Thunberg through the book of Greta and the Giants and also writing a diary entry from the perspective of Florence Nightingale.

We will also be reading George's Marvellous Medicine where we will write instructions for our own medicine.

PE

In PE, we will be focusing on handball and gymnastics. We will be revisiting key gymnastics skills. We will also be learning to effectively throw and catch and applying this within the game of handball.

Art

We will be taking inspiration from Paul Klee using hot and cold colours to create a painted portrait of Florence Nightingale.

Music

We will be learning to respond to melodies and begin to recognise loops and repeated notes in songs.

Maths

- ❖ We will be recapping on the names of 3D shapes and learning about the properties of these shapes.
- ❖ We will be learning to multiply and divide. We will be learning to multiply and divide numbers by 2, 5 and 10 using arrays and practical apparatus.
- ❖ We will be learning to choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure mass (kg/g); temperature (°C); capacity (litres/ml) to the nearest appropriate unit, using scales thermometers and measuring vessels.

Science

We will be learning about the basic needs of humans and animals for survival. We will also be exploring the importance of humans exercising, eating a balanced diet and having good hygiene.

History

We will be learning about Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole and their work during the Crimean war. We will be using historical sources to understand how Florence Nightingale changed the nursing profession and why she is an important person in history. We will also learn about Mary Seacole and compare these two historical figures looking at how they are similar and different.

RE

Our topic for this half term is People Jesus Met. We will explore what change means. Using our own experiences of change we will consider how Jesus changed the lives of people he met in Bible stories.

PSHE

As part of Jigsaw we will be looking at 'Dreams and Goals' this half term. We will be thinking about what realistic goals are and how we can achieve our goals through small steps.

Computing

We will be recapping on our key computing skills and we will be using technology purposefully to support our research. We will also learn about how to stay safe using the internet.
