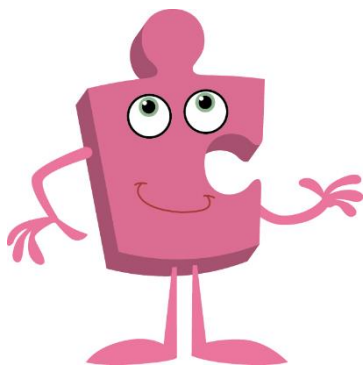
What I already know...
