

RE - Waiting



Overview:

In this **RE** topic you will get the opportunity for enjoyment and fascination about your own lives and those of others. You will think about how Advent is a special time of waiting for Christmas for many Christians. You will know that the four Sundays leading up to Christmas make up the period of Advent.

What I already know...

- That many Christians believe that Christmas day celebrates the day that Jesus was born.
- That Jesus is an important person to many Christians.

Relevant significant dates for many Christians:

Advent – In the year 2023 Sunday 3rd December marks the start of Advent.

Christmas Day – 25th December

(traditionally lasts 12 days so the last day of Christmas is 5^{th} January)
