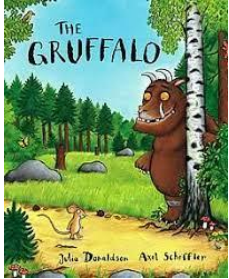

Overview

During this unit, we will have the chance to make our very own Gruffalo Crumble (yummy apple crumble)! We are going to write our own recipes for Gruffalo Crumble using rhyming pairs and have a go at labelling them. We will also learn the story of 'The Gruffalo' and have a go at retelling it and then sequencing the story to show the journey of the mouse.

By the end of this unit...

- I will be able to say some words that rhyme.
- I will be able to write initial sounds, or CVC words.
- I will be able to sequence pictures of the story using the language first, then, next, finally.
- I will be able to retell the journey of the mouse.
