Overview:

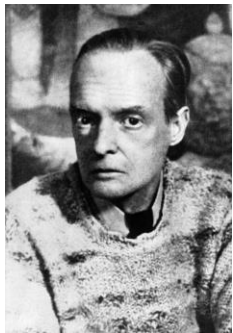
