



RE – Belonging



Overview:

*In this **RE** topic* you will get the opportunity to understand what means to belong is. We explore the different things we belong including family, groups and clubs. You will learn about Christians and learn about the story of when Jesus began to have followers and how they belonged. You will know why Christians feel they belong.

What I already know...

- That many Christians believe that Christmas day celebrates the day that Jesus was born.
- That Jesus is an important person to many Christians.

Keep stories from the bible:

- Jesus calling his first 12 followers (called apostles) who were fishermen in Luke 5:1-11.
- Jesus and the feeding of the 5000 who were all people who had come to listen and to follow Jesus but there wasn't enough food to feed them all (Luke 9: 10-17).

By the end of this unit...

You will be able to:

- express creatively their own responses to *belonging*
- recognise how their response to the idea of *belonging* relates to their own lives.
- recognise what has been taught about the concept of *belonging*
- recognise how Christians may show that they *belong* to the Christian religion
- in simple terms recognise something of the value of *belonging* to Christians, and identify an issue raised.
